

# Confetti Sampler

Finished Size: 22" x 22"

## Step 1

From assorted fabrics sew four  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks together to create a  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " four-patch block, press. Trace one each of small, med. and large heart to paper side of paper-backed fusible web, cut apart leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of assorted fabrics; cut out on drawn line, fuse to center of one four-patch block;

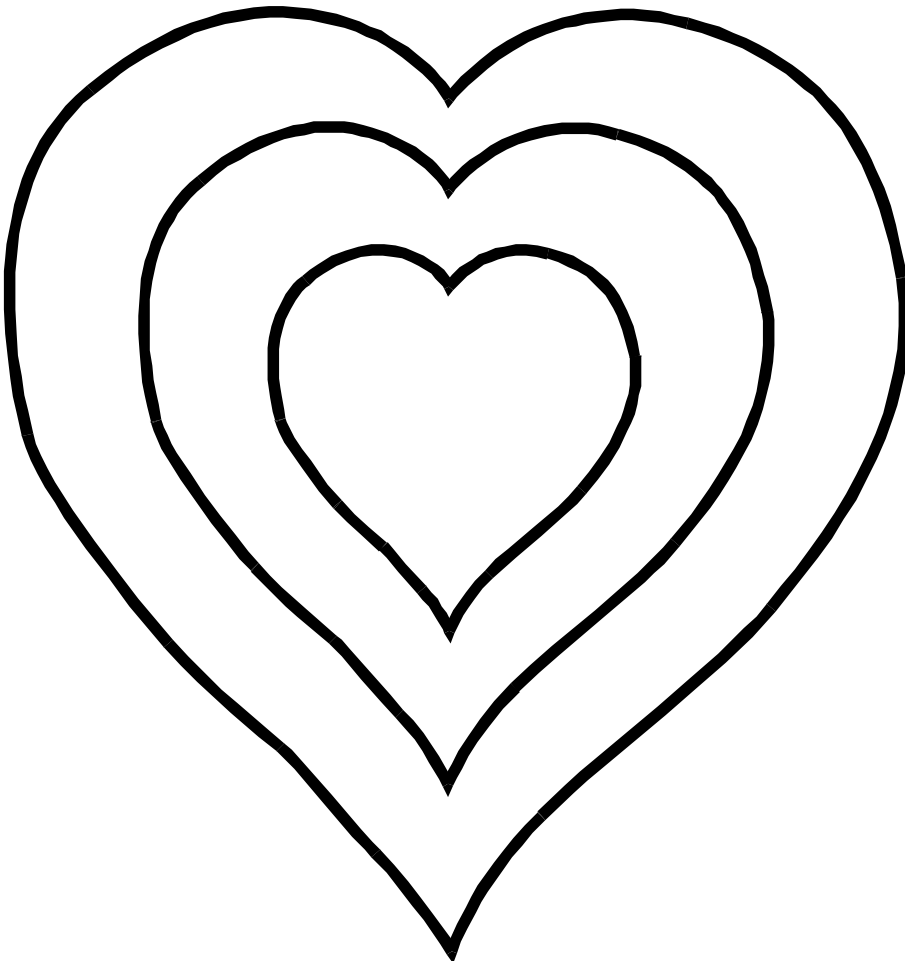
matching thread and fabric color, appliqué edges with blanket stitch.

## Step 2

With a fabric marker, trace heart lines to center of remaining four-patch blocks. Remove tear-away backing from *Chenille By The Inch™*. Transfer small heart to one corner of 8 assorted *Chenille By The Inch™* pieces centering on presewn lines. Cut out 8 assorted hearts. Sew chenille hearts to center heart of each four-patch block, stitching on *Chenille By The Inch™* presewn lines and back tacking at beginning and end of each stitched line to secure. Using scissors cut chenille in the center between the stitched lines, being sure not to cut the background fabric.

## Step 3

Using the *Chenille Cutting Guide™*, and cutting between the stitched lines with a rotary cutter, cut remaining *Chenille By The Inch™* into strips. Following transferred heart lines on block, sew *Chenille By the Inch™* to blocks, back tacking at beginning and end of each strip.



## Materials

50" each of 8 assorted colors of *Confetti Chenille By The Inch™*

From assorted mottled fabrics cut:  
36,  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares  
1 each of small, medium & large heart

From  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. of black mottled fabric cut:  
6,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for sashing  
6,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for sashing & border  
3,  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF for binding

Water-soluble fabric marker

Paper-backed fusible web

Sewing thread to match fabric

26" square cotton batting

26" square backing fabric

*Chenille Brush* and *Chenille Cutting Guide*

Spray bottle with distilled water

## Step 4

Assemble wall hanging by sewing three rows of three blocks alternating heart blocks and black  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing pieces, press. Sew rows together with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips between each row and on top and bottom, trim ends even, press. Sew  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip to each side of wall hanging, press, trim ends even with top and bottom. Layer and baste quilt top for quilting method of your choice. Quilt as desired. Sew black  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF binding strips together end to end, press wrong side together matching raw edges. Matching right side of binding to front side of quilt, sew mitering corners. Press binding to back of quilt, hand stitch in place.

## Step 5

Using a spray bottle with distilled water, dampen sewn *Chenille By The Inch™*; using a *Chenille Brush™*, brush vigorously to fluff chenille.

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
