

# Flower Towel Trim

**Finished Size**  
Design size 5 ¼ x 7"

Chenille By The Inch	
Color	Amount
#25 Jelly Bean (purple)	25"
Other Materials	
Water-soluble fabric marker	
Paper-back fusible web	
Purple, green & beige thread for embroidery	
Sewing thread	
Hand towel	
Chenille Brush™ and Olfa® Chenille Cutter™	
Spray bottle with distilled water	

## Step 1

Trace flower, leaf and stem patterns to paper side of paper-backed fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut apart on drawn line.

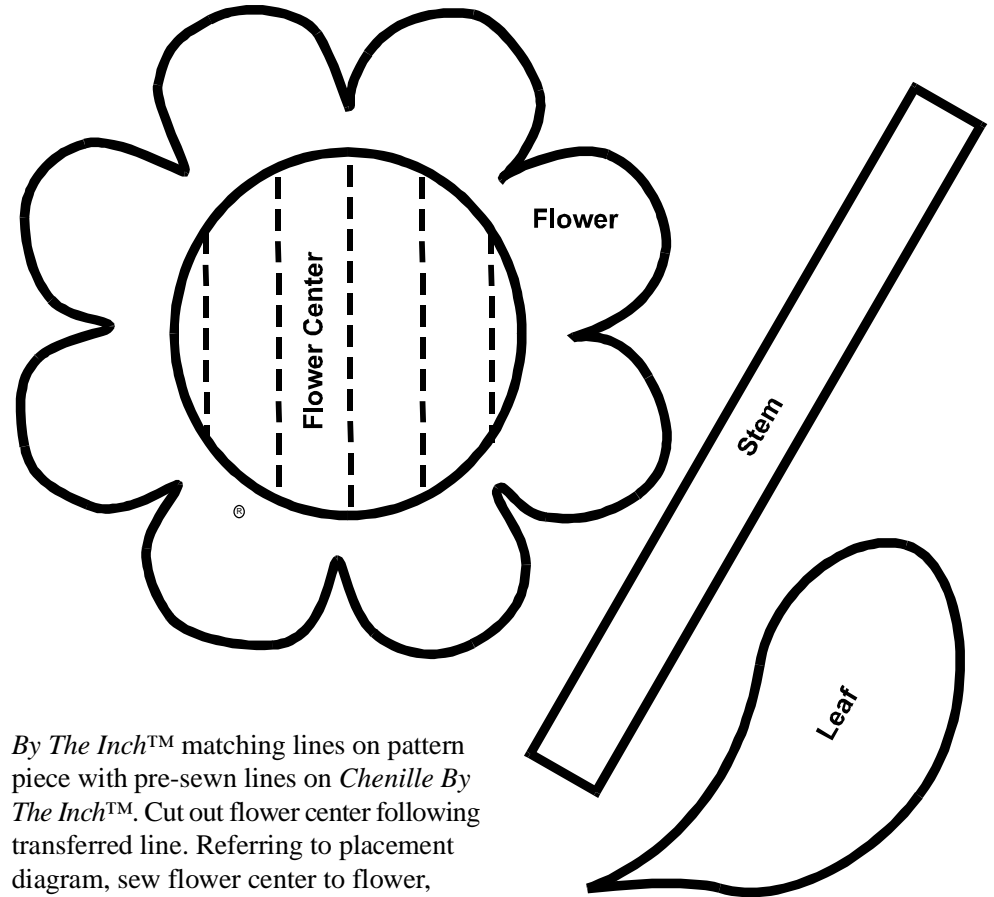
## Step 2

Following manufacturer's instructions, referring to pattern for placement, fuse patterns to center of 5 ¾" x 7 ½" green check square. Appliqué edges using blanket stitch and purple for flower, green for leaves and beige for stem.

## Step 3

Remove tear-away backing from *Chenille By The Inch*™. For flower center, transfer flower center pattern to Jelly Bean *Chenille*

Fabric	Yardage	#of Pieces to Cut	Dimensions
Green check for background block	small amount	1	5 ¾" x 7 ½"
Yellow print for flower	small amount	1	Flower Pattern
Green print for leaves	small amount	1 1	Leaf Pattern Leaf Pattern Reversed
Beige for stem	small amount	1	Stem pattern



*By The Inch*™ matching lines on pattern piece with pre-sewn lines on *Chenille By The Inch*™. Cut out flower center following transferred line. Referring to placement diagram, sew flower center to flower, stitching on *Chenille By The Inch*™ pre-sewn lines and back-tacking at beginning and end of each stitched line to secure. Cut in the center between the stitched lines using the *Olfa*® *Chenille Cutter*™ and being sure not to cut the flower fabric.

## Step 4

Press edges of flower square under ¼", center and pin 3" from bottom edge of hand towel. Appliqué edges of square using blanket stitch and purple embroidery thread.

## Step 5

Using a spray bottle with water, dampen sewn *Chenille By The Inch*™ with water; using a *Chenille Brush*™, brush vigorously to fluff chenille.
