Color	Amount
Banana #08	200"
Other Materials	
Water-soluble fabric marker	
Paper-back fusible webbing	
Sewing thread to match fabric	
4 black 1/4" shank buttons for eyes	
16" square backing fabric	
16" square cotton batting	
<i>Chenille Brush™</i> & <i>Chenille Cutting Guide™</i>	
Spray bottle with water	

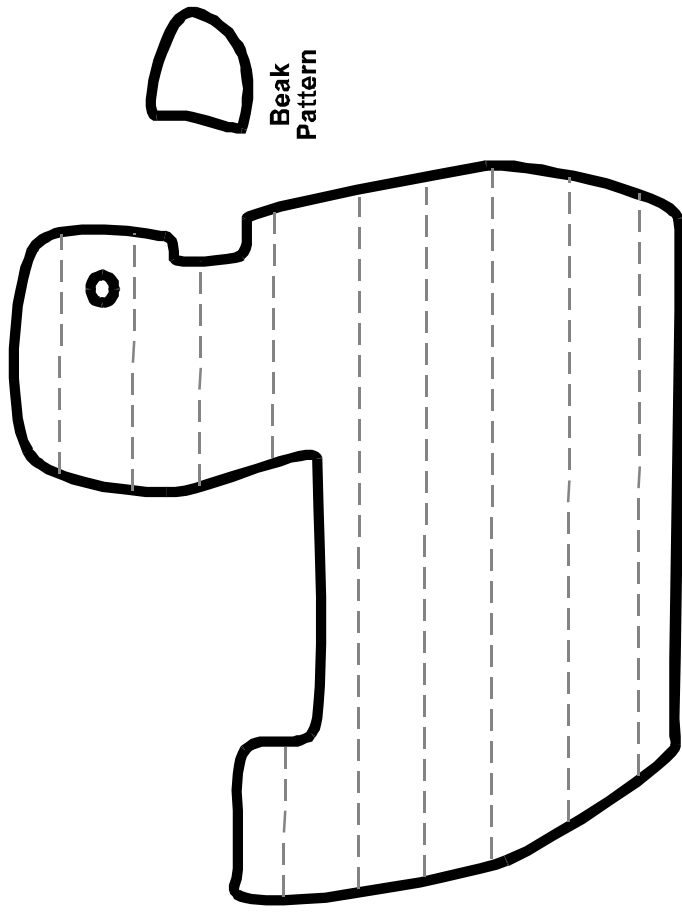
Step 1

Cut out fabric pieces following fabric chart. Trace beak pattern to paper side of paper-backed fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse to wrong side of orange fabric; cut on drawn line. Referring to photo and pattern for placement, fuse beak to center of blue blocks; matching thread and fabric color, appliqué with blanket stitch.

Step 2

Remove tear-away backing from *Chenille By The Inch™*. Trace duck pattern to center of *Chenille by the Inch™* matching dotted lines to pre-sewn lines. Cut out duck following traced lines. Sew ducks to center of blue blocks, stitching on each

pre-sewn line and back tacking at the beginning and end of each sewn line.

Step 3

Referring to photo for placement, assemble wall hanging by sewing 2 1/2" dotted strip between two blocks, trim strip even with top and bottom. Repeat with remaining two blocks. Sew 2 1/2" dotted strip between top two blocks and bottom blocks, trim ends even with sides. Sew 2 1/2" dotted strip to each side of center piece section, trim ends even with top and bottom. Sew 2 1/2" dotted strip to each top and bottom, trim ends even with sides.

Step 4

Layer and baste wall hanging top for quilting method of your choice. Quilt as desired. Matching right side of binding to front side of quilt, sew mitering corners. Press binding to back of quilt, hand stitch in place.

Step 5

Using a chenille cutter cut chenille channels. Using a spray bottle with distilled water, dampen sewn *Chenille By The Inch™*, using a *Chenille Brush™*, brush vigorously to fluff chenille. Sew on buttons for eyes.
