

# Sunshine Baby Jacket

**Fabric Requirements**  
Bright Green, small amount

**Other Materials**

- *Chenille By The Inch*™  
06 Raspberry 90"  
07 Limeade 120"  
10 Grape Soda 30"
- *Chenille Brush*™
- *Chenille Cutting Guide*™
- Water soluble fabric marker
- Yellow Sweatshirt
- One 1" button

**Cutting the Fabric**

- Bright Green
- Cut 2 strips 1 1/4" x 9 1/4"
- Cut 2 button tabs

**Jacket**

**Note: use 1/4" seam allowance throughout.**

**Step 1**

Cut bottom and sleeve bands from sweatshirt, trimming to desired length. Cut center front open.

**Step 2**

Turn under bottom edge up 1/4", topstitch. Turn under center front edges 1/4", topstitch. For each sleeve, fold long edge of green strip under 1/4", press. Holding right side of unpressed edge to right side of sleeve, sew. Fold sleeve band in half to wrong side, matching stitching line from front pressed edge, topstitch. Fold collar band in half, topstitch.

**Step 3**

For button tab, with right sides together, sew, leaving small end unsewn. Trim point, turn, press. Turn under raw edge 1/4", press. Sew button hole to center of tab. Sew open edge to under side of left front, 3/4" from neck edge. Sew on button.

**Step 4**

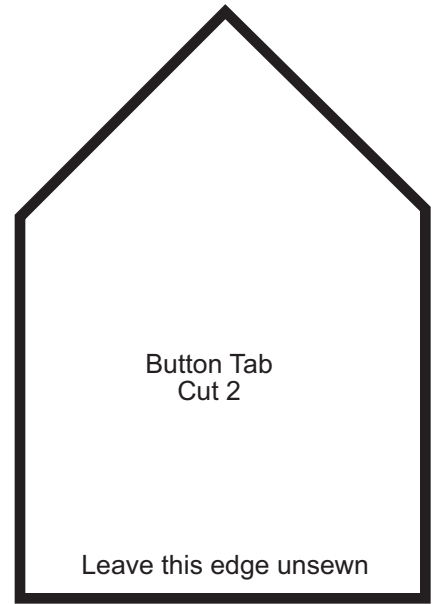
Using the water-soluble fabric marker, transfer flower pattern to bottom edge of jacket.

**Step 5**

Remove tear-away backing from *Chenille By The Inch*™. Using the *Chenille Cutting Guide*™, and cutting between the stitching lines with a rotary cutter, cut into long strips. Following chenille placement lines on pattern, sew *Chenille By The Inch*™ to jacket. Sew Raspberry chenille to center front edge, around collar and cuffs.

**Step 6**

Using a spray bottle with water, dampen sewn *Chenille By The Inch*™ strips; using a *Chenille Brush*™, brush vigorously to fluff chenille.
